



TRI COUNTY SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY FAIR FAQs

Who Can Enter?

The Fair is a regional K-12 competition for students that win at their local school Fair.

- ◆ Students who attend school in Westchester, Putnam and Rockland counties are eligible to compete (you can live elsewhere as long as your school is in one of these counties)
- ◆ Group projects are limited to three students attending the same school within the same division: Grades 9-12 HS Grades 5-8 MS and Grades K-4 ES

What if my school isn't having a Fair?

- ◆ High School students can always direct enter with a science teachers approval. The science teacher needs to fill out a HS Intent to Participate form
- ◆ If your K-8 child previously competed in Tri county (the past 5 years) **AND** your current school is **NOT** holding a school Fair ask a science teacher to contact us from a school email to learn what to do next: JNewman@DiscoveryCtr.org

What if my school cannot pay the entry fees?

- ◆ High School students can always self pay with a science teachers approval. The science teacher needs to fill out a HS Intent to Participate form
- ◆ We strongly suggest students in grades K-8 ask the PTA or interested parents to pool money to pay the flat school fee. Individual parent pay is costly and still requires the permission from the principal or a science teacher. Parent pay is only cost effective if less than 4 projects want to come to the Fair.

When is the deadline to enter?

It is always April 1. It is recommended to get entries in early to avoid last minute issues with registration.
